2023 has been another year of increases! Financial Assistance increased almost double over last year. People assisted increased monthly.

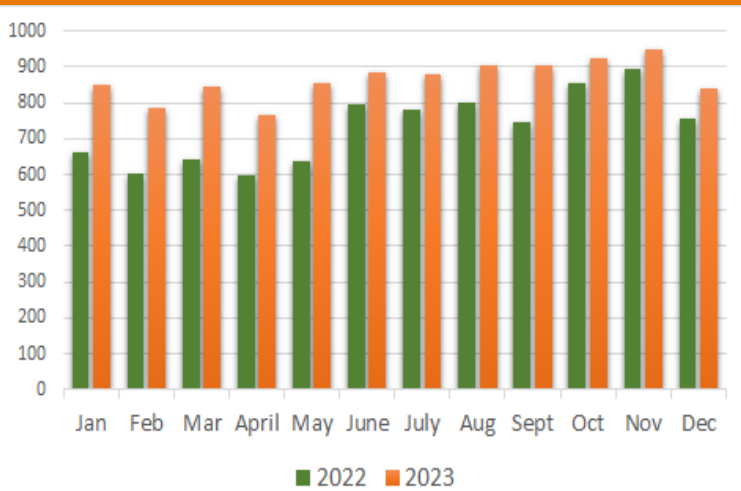
Our partnership with Feeding America has allowed us to provide a full range of healthy foods including meats and fresh vegetables to our neighbors in need.

Number of People Served Monthly



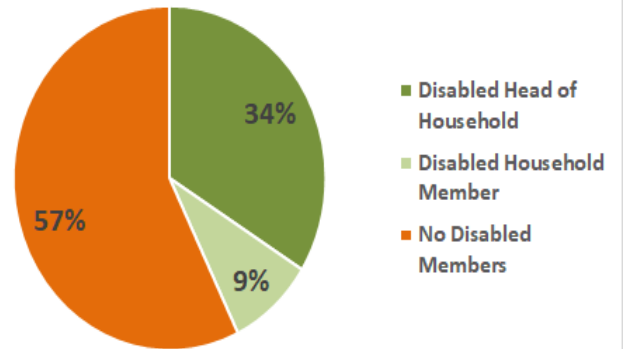

If you know of someone who may qualify for this, encourage them to apply!

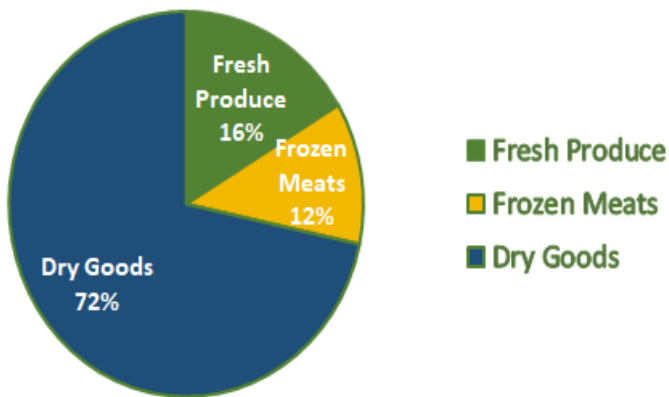
VITA Tax Program Volunteer Income Tax Assistance

In 2023, the LCGS tax office completed 360 tax returns for tax year 2022.

Assuming average tax return prep / fees of \$250, this program saved these taxpayers \$90,000 in fees.

An additional 15 prior year returns were completed for an additional \$3,750 in savings.

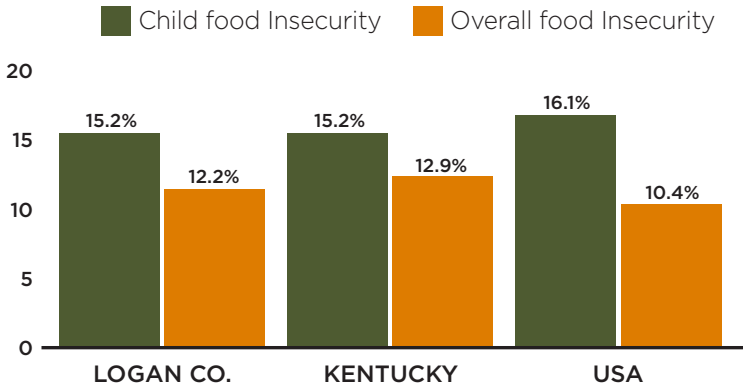
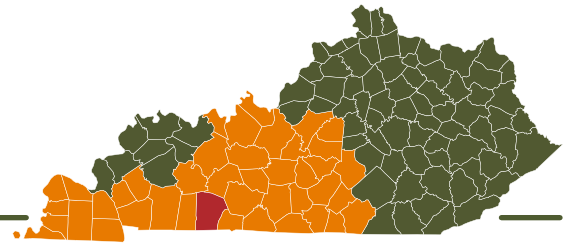
Types of Food Distributed

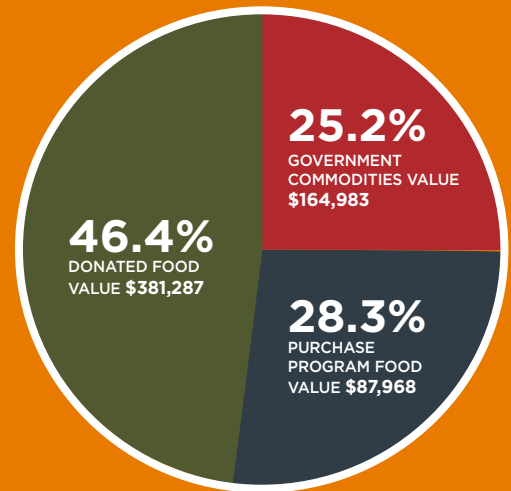
FOOD INSECURITY

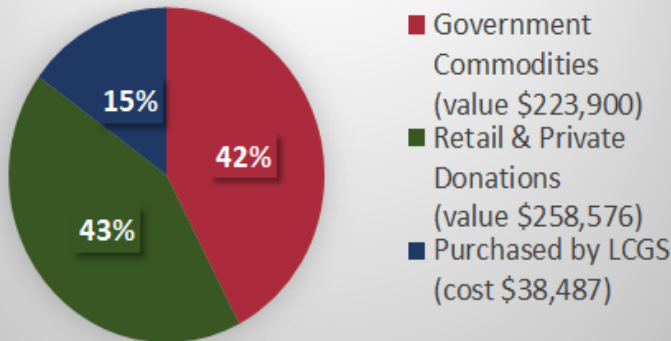
